Brooke was a two-time Illinois High School Rodeo state finalist in pole bending and barrel racing. She was the 2007 Junior Barrel Racing Champion at the Sharon Camarillo Eastern Classic.

Brooke is the daughter of Brian and Gina Owen. She has two brothers Kolton and Kordel and a sister Morgen.

Brooke will begin her reign as Miss Rodeo Illinois on Jan. 1, 2011. She will travel throughout the U.S. to promote professional rodeo and the state of Illinois as she prepares to compete in the Miss Rodeo America pageant in Las Vegas, Nev., in December 2011. In the absence of a pageant this year Brooke subsequently approached the National Director. Following the selection process which entailed an exam, speech, modeling, impromptu questions and interview, Brooke was appointed by the MRI Board of Directors Oct. 17.
