The Miss Rodeo Illinois Pageant is open to any female resident of the State of Illinois or student attending college in Illinois who is at least 19 years of age and not older than 26 before Dec. 31, 2015. Candidates must be single, never married, pregnant nor with dependent(s). The Miss titleholder will represent the state of Illinois at the Miss Rodeo America Pageant in Las Vegas, Nev. December 2015. She is expected to attend the 2015 Miss Rodeo America Pageant in Las Vegas, Nev. Nov. 30-Dec. 6, 2014.

Miss Teen Rodeo Illinois pageant contestants must be 13-18 years of age. Horsemanship skills are required for both categories. The contestants selected will be named the Miss Rodeo Illinois Lady-in-Waiting and Miss Teen Rodeo Lady-in-Waiting. They will begin their reign Jan. 1, 2014

She is the 22-year-old daughter of Dennis and Cheryl Perry of Spring Bay, Ill. She is a graduate of Illinois Central College where she earned an Associate's Degree in Agriculture. Like most young girls, Katie dreamed of having her own horse. She did not have parents who grew up around horses, let alone had any experience with them like many of the people in the horse industry, but she did have supportive parents and that's all she could ask for. At the age of ten, her parents blessed her with her first horse. From that day on, she has won many classes and championships over the years, but more times than none she did not take home the prize. But she has never allowed herself to stay down. Katie has always gotten back up and brushed off her jeans and went for another go-round. Her life has revolved around learning from others as well as learning from experiences in hopes of becoming a good influence on someone else. She believes she can do just that by wearing the crown of Miss Rodeo Illinois and she couldn't be more honored.

She is a member of the American Quarter Horse Association (AQHA), American Ranch Horse Association (ARHA), National Cutting Horse Association (NCHA), Ranch Sorting National Championships (RSNC), Illinois Quarter Horse Association (IQHA) and the Illinois Ranch Horse Association (ILRHA). Throughout her childhood, she participated in 4-H and open horse shows across Illinois. She is the 2008 Section 5 FFA Horsemanship and Western Pleasure Champion, 2009 Section 5 FFA Halter and Showmanship Champion, 2010 State 4-H 2010 AQHA Registered Halter Mare Reserve Champion, 2010 7th place State 4-H Showmanship exhibitor, 2011 10th place State 4-H AQHA Registered Halter Mare, 2011 Marshall-Putnam County Fair Reserve Grand Champion winner, along with many other open horse show championships with a focus on showmanship and halter. She now competes in Ranch Sorting. She is the 2012-2013 ILRHA Winter Series +1 Sort High Point Champion.



This year she had been traveling throughout the U.S. promoting the sport of Professional Rodeo and the State of Illinois, the equine industry, and the western way of life as she prepares to compete in the 60th Miss Rodeo America Pageant. She had been to many PRCA ProRodeos including big name rodeos such as the Denver Stock Show in Denver, CO, the Ram National Circuit Finals Rodeo in Guthrie, OK, the Buffalo Bill Rodeo and NEBRASKALand Days in North Platte, NE, the Calgary Stampede in Calgary, AB, Canada, Cheyenne Frontier Days in Cheyenne, WY, the Dodge City Roundup Rodeo in Dodge City, KS. She is so blessed to have this pageant in her state at an amazing ProRodeo! After Palestine, she will head to Fort Madison, IA for the Tri-State Rodeo (Illinois, Iowa, and Missouri), and will finish her rodeo travels at the Great Lakes Circuit Finals Rodeo in Louisville, KY. Katie also attend the ProRodeo Hall of Fame Inductions in Colorado Springs, CO, as well as participated in the Miss Rodeo Texas Pageant. Aside from the rodeo appearances, Katie has visited many schools, nursing homes, helped with Central Illinois Riding Therapy (CIRT), raised money for St. Jude, and promotes the Dax Locke Foundation.

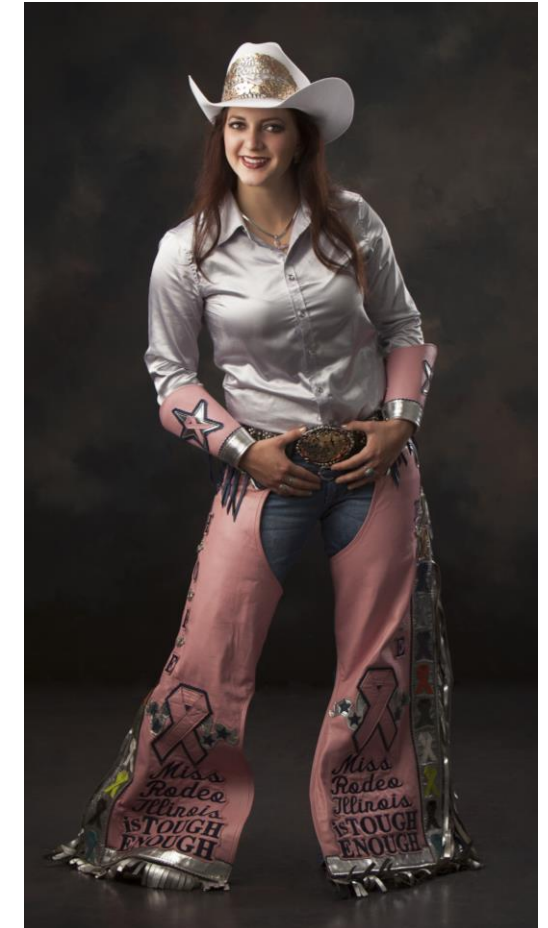
