Rebecca Marie Kloker is the 22 year old daughter of Norm and Jean Kloker from Rushville, Ill. She was crowned Miss Rodeo Illinois 2009 last August at the PRCA rodeo in Palestine, IL.

Rebecca is a licensed cosmetologist and a graduate of the University of Spa and Cosmetology Arts in Springfield, Ill.

Not raised in what one would call a "horse family" Rebecca's passion for horses was evident at a young age. When she was 10 years old her uncle purchased Buddy, a six year old Quarter Horse gelding, for her. Thus began her odyssey from 4-H Shows, to competing in the Illinois High School Rodeo Association all four years, then qualifying for the National High School Finals Rodeo in 2005 in barrel racing.

As the reigning Miss Rodeo Illinois, Rebecca's schedule has been full of making appearances at various PRCA rodeos across the country, including; Denver National Stock Show and Rodeo, San Antonio Livestock Show and Rodeo, Silver Spurs Rodeo in Kissimmee, Florida, Dodge Nat'l Circuit Finals in Pocatella, Idaho, also going to pro rodeos in Cherokee Iowa, Monticello Illinois, Pikes Peak or Bust Rodeo in Colorado Springs, Rooftop Rodeo in Estes Park, Colorado, and finally The Daddy of 'Em All, Cheyenne Frontier Days.

Rebecca has been able to visit local schools to share her love of rodeo and horses with kids of all ages. She also made several nursing home and hospital visits during her year.

Rebecca said, "Being Miss Rodeo Illinois has been a dream of mine since I saw my first rodeo queen at age 13 and with a little patience and a lot of perseverance it finally happened. I am so blessed to have family and friends that support me in my dreams. This year has been one wild ride but I wouldn't trade the friends and memories I have made this year for anything"
